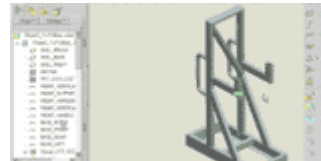

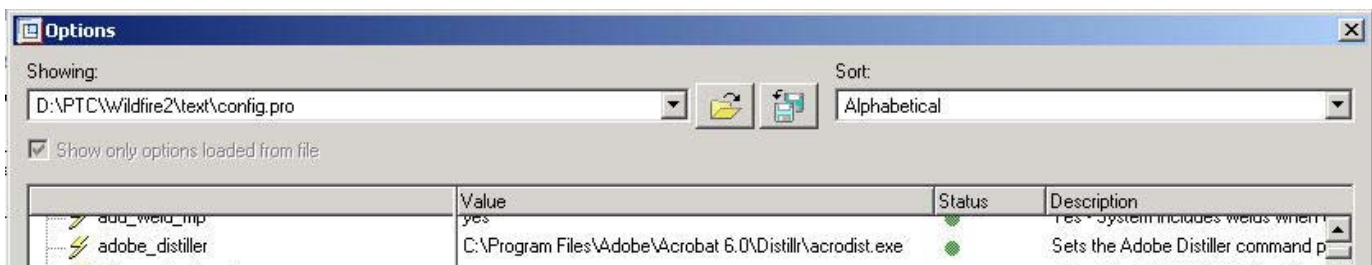
How to Associate Wildfire 2.0 to Adobe

Adobe PDF Setup

This document explains the steps involved in setting up and configuring Pro/Detail to allow for PDF creation directly from Pro Engineer.

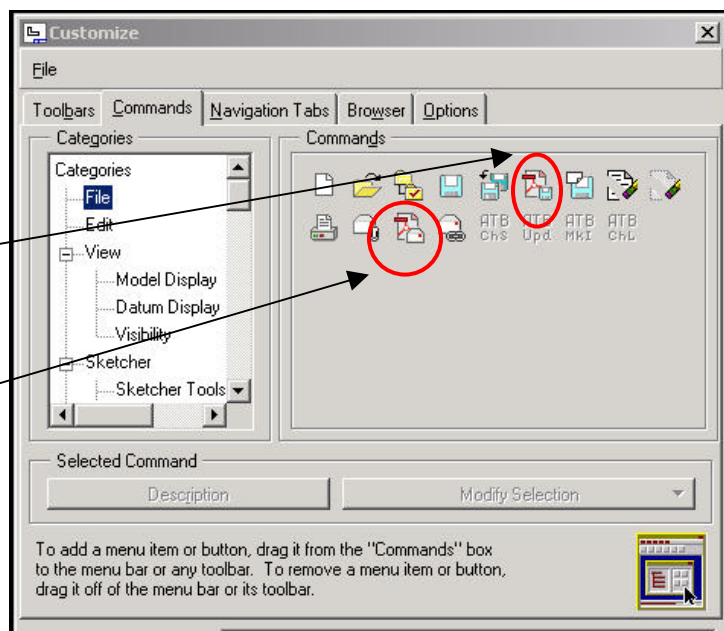
Steps:

- 1) Install Adobe Distiller to any location
- 2) Add a Config.pro setting: **adobe_distiller**
 - a. (NOTE: will only work on builds starting with M010 of WF2.0)
 - b. Now set to location of the distiller install ending with acrodist.exe



- c. Save this new Config.pro setting
- 3) Start a new drawing
- 4) Modify your Config.win file

- a. Go to Tools/Customize Screen
- b. Locate the following 2 icons
 - i. Save Object as PDF
 - ii. Email Object as PDF



c. Drag these two icons to your desired location



d. Save the Config.win

Comments:

If your Plot File Directory is set to a different location, then the PDF file will be placed in that directory. If not then it will be placed in your working directory

There is also a pdf_plot_Config that may be set to the desired pdf file if needed.

Angled Holes : From 4 Pattern Features to One

This example demonstrates how to create an angled hole that most commonly would be done in by creating 4 separate patterns. By following a curve and point the pattern can be done in one simple pattern.

Functionality used in example:

1. Ref Pattern
2. Advanced Datum plane reference on the fly
3. Using Points – Ratio
4. Sketched Curves
